

PSPRS Cancer Insurance Policy Program

Arizona law provides all active first responders and members of the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System with coverage under its **Cancer Insurance Policy Program**. This coverage is also available to members of the Corrections Officer Retirement Plan who elect to receive coverage through participating employers.

The CIPP provides covered members and retirees with payments for diagnoses of all types of cancer. The program also offers advanced reimbursements to help pre-pay for covered treatment-related expenses.

Each year, the Cancer Insurance Policy Program provides eligible members and retirees with direct benefits and/or reimbursements for out-of-pocket costs for the following:

- *Initial diagnosis of cancer, including skin cancer*
- Subsequent diagnosis of cancer (non-skin)
- Intensive care treatment
- Pharmaceuticals
- Experimental treatments
- Imaging, scans, radiation and chemotherapy

- Genomic and genetic testing
- Hospital confinement
- Skilled nursing facilities
- Home hospice care
- Hospice care
- Death

Pharmacy	Subject to overall lifetime maximum	
Genomic and genetic testing	Maximum benefit amount; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 15,000
Experimental treatment	Maximum benefit amount; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 5,000
Hospital confinement daily	Daily benefit; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 200
Cancer intensive care	Daily benefit; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 500
Skilled nursing facility	Daily benefit; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 40
Home hospice care	Daily benefit; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 50
Hospice care	Daily benefit; Reimbursement not to exceed actual incurred expenses	\$ 180
Death	Not subject to lifetime maximum	\$10,000
